## **Competition Structure and Important Information**

- Junior Grade is Year 9-10 students only.
- Senior Grade is Year 11-13 students only.
- FIBA rules apply, but no 24 second shot clock.
- Referees will be assigned by BM for all SS Social Games.
- Games will be x4 10-minute running clock quarters.
- Games will be played with a SIZE 7 ball.
- Games will be scored on iPads using the Glory League Scoring app. Only registered players may take the court for a game anybody not registered will be asked to leave the court.
- Teams must have one proficient and experienced person on the bench to do duty for their own game. Team A will do Glory League, Team B will do flip chart. Happy for you to swap if both parties agree.
- No time outs!
- Mouthguards are COMPULSORY for all players.
- The 3, 5 and 8 second rules will apply, as too will the back over half rule.
- Subs to be made on a whistle, no rolling subs. Referees will call subs into the game from the score-table.
- Fouls will be called and recorded; players can only receive 5 fouls before they are fouled out of the game (cannot return).
- Free throws are to be given for shooting fouls. Each quarter a team may have 4 team fouls, on the 5<sup>th</sup> team foul and every foul thereafter, 2 free throws are to be awarded.
- Teams are to play a man-on-man defence.
- In the event of a tied game, the final score stands as a Draw. In a Semi or a Final, a 2-minute extra time-period will be played to determine a winner. Personal and team fouls will remain the same as at the end of regular time.
- All players must be registered in GAMEDAY to receive Glory league.
- There must be an ADULT present and supervising each team.
- Please do NOT bring balls into the facility, BM will supply warm-up and game balls for all teams.
- BM will host a Coach workshop at CET Arena to discuss and go over rules and expectations, and to share the rationale behind any new changes. *Date will be confirmed by Friday 1 March.* Session will be facilitated by Tess Petley and Willie Bryant from Basketball Manawatu.
